

## NEW TOWN ANNUAL SCHOOL ELECTION

Two three-year positions on the New Town School Board are to be filled at the Annual School Election, June 11, 2019. Members whose three-year terms expire are Delvin Driver, Jr., who represents the South Area and Nicholette Lahtinen, who represents the North Area.

Monday, April 8, 2019 at 4 p.m. is the deadline for filing of candidates who wish to have their names appear on the ballot in the June 11, 2019 school election. Candidates must be resident voters of the area designated. Those who wish to have their name appear on the ballot as candidates may pick up forms at the New Town Public School Business Office which is located in the High School/Middle School building. Candidates will also have to file a Statement of Intent Form which is also available in the school Business Office.

The election will be held June 11, 2019 with the balloting for candidates limited to voters residing in the North and South areas of the New Town Public School District.

NORTH RURAL AREA is the area east of Lake Sakakawea, north of Highway 23 and includes the area within city limits west of Highway 1804 to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street South.

SOUTH RURAL AREA is the area east of Lake Sakakawea, south of Highway 23 and includes the area within the city limits south of Eagle Drive (2<sup>nd</sup> Street) from Highway 1804 to College Drive, with the exception of the area between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street South and 4<sup>th</sup> Street South from East Avenue to West Avenue (Previously known as the Prairie Winds Trailer Court Area).
